



RIVERMIST WALL CONSTRUCTION FAQ

When will construction begin and end?

We will commence onsite work within the next 30 days and complete construction in approximately four to six months.

What can homeowners expect during construction?

Construction will take place five days per week, Monday through Friday from 7am through 6pm.

We anticipate noise levels to be consistent with normal homebuilding construction and have developed traffic routes approved by the HOA to minimize traffic disruptions throughout the neighborhood during the construction process.

There will be approximately forty construction workers working on the wall throughout the process. All of the construction workers will have badges and carry IDs in order to be easily identified.

How is Centex keeping the community safe throughout this process?

In order to address safety concerns, we have installed barriers around the wall area so that children won't be tempted to use the construction area as a shortcut.

We will be instructing our contractors to implement the usual procedures to secure a construction site, but we also ask that you remind your children that this is a work site and should be considered off limits during construction. We are focused on keeping the community safe during the rebuilding process.

What will the wall finish look like? How will the area be landscaped?

The wall finish will match as closely as possible the existing walls within the community.

Once construction is complete, we will landscape the area with more than 80 major native trees, including Live, Burr and Red Oak, Lacebark Elm, Mountain Laurel, Texas Redbud and Persimmon. Each tree will be relatively mature, averaging 4 to 8 years in age and 10' to 16' in height. At maturity, the largest trees will grow to 30' to 50' in height.
