Dear Homeowner:

Yesterday, Centex representatives met with City officials to present the engineered design plans for performing the first phase of slope stabilization work at the Hills of Rivermist.

Before anything else can be done, the first step to implementing a solution is to stabilize the slope. The work to be performed will include drilling and inserting a series of stabilizing piers in an engineered pattern across the slope failure area, specifically along the four home sites at the top of the hillside. These piers will stabilize the area so that soil and damaged portions of the wall can be removed. This step will allow us to begin building a new wall.

I'm pleased to tell you we have received City approval of the plans and obtained the necessary permit to begin the work for this phase. We expect to begin tomorrow, Wednesday, March 17, 2010 and for the work related to stabilization to last up to thirty days.
